Native trees are not invasive which means they will not take over an area with unrestricted growth. It is important not to create a monoculture of one species, diversity is the key in any healthy landscape.

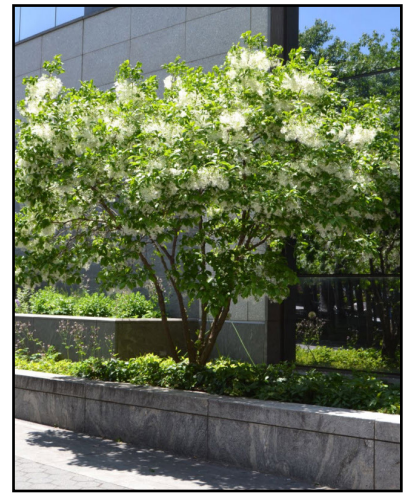

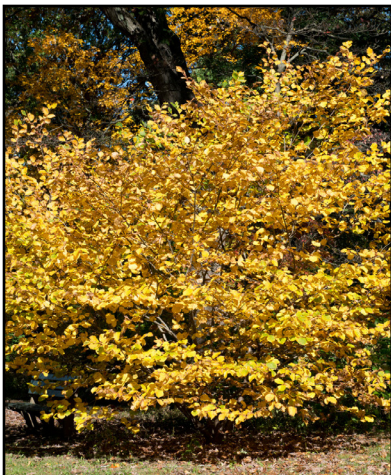

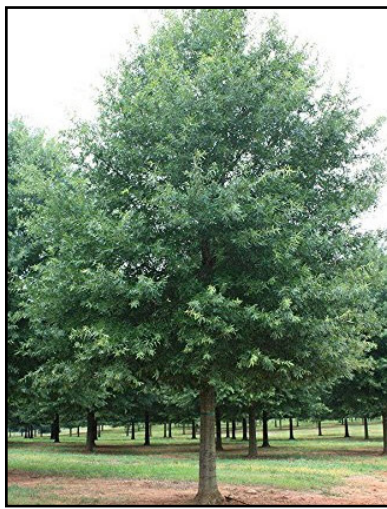
