18 Blue Foliage Plants We Sell



Blue Atlas Cedar
 Cedrus Atlantic 'Glauca'
 Bright blue foliage in an evergreen tree that grows up to 50' tall and 40' wide. Unique upright branching structure.



Weeping Blue Atlas Cedar
 'Cedrus Atlantic 'Glauca Pendula'
 The weeping form of this bright blue evergreen. Every plant develops its own unique character. Can be a stunning specimen. Grows 10 - 12' tall, width can be well over 20' in time.



Feelin' Blue Deodar Cedar
Cedrus deodara 'Feelin' Blue'

Reaches 4 to 5 ft. tall, spreading 6 to 10 ft. Blue-green foliage is a wonderful specimen for smaller spaces, rock gardens and containers.



Blue Point Juniper
Juniper chinensis 'Blue Point'

Pyramidal - dense blue-green needles. Grows 12-15' tall and 6- 8' wide. Great corner piece where you have limited space to work with.



Blue Pacific Juniper
Juniper conferta 'Blue Pacific'

Ground cover - grows 6-12" tall.
Bright blue foliage.



Icee Blue Juniper
Juniper horizontalis 'Icee Blue'
Low trailing juniper - best blue color



Blue Rug Juniper
Juniper 'wiltoni'
Ground cover - grows 3-6" tall.

A Note About Blue Color

Some of the plants in this PDF don't look very Blue. The reasons are: Blue can develop with age and blue is a hard color to photograph in plants.



Blue Star Juniper

Juniper squamata 'Blue Star'

Grows 2-3' tall and 3-4' wide. Bright blue foliage. Great little specimen.



Colorado Blue Spruce

Juniper chinensis 'Blue Point'

Dense pyramidal tree with horizontal branching. Tolerated drought better than other spruce. Foliage varies from blue-green to blue.



Baby Blue Spruce

Picea pungens 'Baby Blue'

Dense - highly symmetrical form that grows in a tight pyramid to 40' tall by 20-25' wide. Good color.



Fat Albert Blue Spruce

Picea pungens 'Fat Albert'

Only grows 10-15' tall and 8-10' wide. Strong Blue color. Typically a more uniform shape than picture implies.



Hoopsi Blue Spruce
Picea pungens 'Hoopsii'

Intense silvery-blue color. Not perfectly uniform - each plant has its own character. Grows 30-40' tall and 20-25' wide.



Columnar Blue Spruce
Picea pungens 'Fastigiata'

Matures at a height of 15 - 25' with a width of only 4-6'



Globosa Blue Spruce
Picea pungens 'Globosa'

Grows 3.5' tall and 4-6' wide. Beautifully rounded shape. Great Blue color.



Montgomery Blue Spruce
Picea pungens 'Fat Albert'

Broadly rounded compact shrub grows slowly to 4-5' tall and wide. Great Blue color.



Sester Dwarf Blue Spruce
Picea pungens 'Sester Dwarf'

A slow growing dwarf form of the famous Colorado Blue Spruce, Seters Dwarf grows only 10' tall and 4-6' wide. Stunning Blue needles.



Bonny Blue Spruce
Picea pungens 'Bonny Blue'

A medium grower to 25' tall and 15' wide. Bright blue uniquely short needles. Keeps a tight shape. Great specimen.
